3. GROUNDSMAN REPORT

The new Christmas tree lights were put on the tree in time for Christmas and the committee commented on how lovely they looked. The tree now has been taken down and cut up and put in our woods in the habitat piles for the wild life. Also, the trees have been trimmed of their dead branches in the woods and they have also been added to the habitat piles. All the paths in the woods have been cleared.
