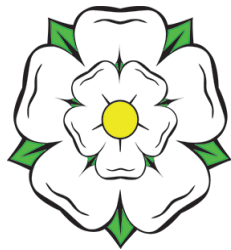
Richmondshire Safer Homes.

Richmondshire Property Marking

Richmondshire Police have access to a DOT PEEN marking system. This device permanently marks many items with an owner's post code and house number. It can be used for most things excluding ceramics and glass.
