#### 3. GROUNDSMAN REPORT

All play park inspections have been completed for this month and there were no issues with any of the parks'equipment. The committee thanked Cllrs Towers and Tutora for repairing the fencing on the Chase parks. A full report of jobs and and repairs to the parks from the Groundsman is below ~

#### 4. GARDENING COMPETITION DATE

The committee discussed different dates for the gardening competition. It was **RESOLVED** that the date for the Gardening competition presentation and Afternoon Tea this year will take place on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2023. #### 5. BROADWAY RAISED BEDS

Cllr Crowe has been planting additional plants into the raised beds, but more soil is require to bring the beds up to a suitable level for more planting to take place. Cllr Towers informed the committee that he would make some enquires to see if he could secure some soil for the raised beds. A working party will then be formed in the near future to add more soil and plants and to regularly maintain the beds.

### 6. LITTER PICK DATES

The dates for next 3 litter picks are Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> February, 4<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> March 2023. Litter bags required. The Groundsman stated he had spare bags and would bring them to the office for the litter picks. It was reported that some of the litter picker grabbers are not working anymore. The last pickers purchased were not expensive and committee think that they should maybe invest in more expensive pickers so they have a longer life span. The Chairman will report to the full Council about this matter as the Open Spaces budget for this financial year has almost been spent.

The committee also requested a breakdown of the expenditure of the Open Spaces budget for the year 22/23 for the next meeting and for future meetings a running cost of expenditure.
